

Dave McNally

Dave McNally is currently in his thirteenth summer as the diving coach at Brookside Swim Club. He graduated from West Chester University where Dave was a two time Honorable Mention All-American diver. During his over two decades of coaching experience, Coach Dave has coached many different summer teams such as Barclay Farms, Green-Fields, Wenonah and Woodcrest. He has led Wenonah and Brookside each to a South Jersey Diving Championship. Dave McNally also served as the president of the South Jersey Diving Association for the previous two years. In addition, Mr. McNally coached the divers at Pitman High School for three years from 2001-2003. Coach Dave was also the head diving coach at Rowan University for eight years as well as starting and running an age group diving program there. Mr. McNally was voted the Metropolitan Diving Coach of the Year in 1998, 2005, and 2007. He coached four Metropolitan Conference Divers of the Year, nine Metropolitan Conference Champions, and fifty-two Metropolitan Conference Finalists. Mr. McNally coached two N.J.A.C. Divers of the year, three Philadelphia Inquirer Academic Performers of the year, and five Philadelphia Inquirer Academic All-Area team members. Coach Dave also has had one Rowan University Richard Wacker Award winner and one Rowan University Briglia Award winner. Last, Mr. McNally coached on CoSIDA/ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District II first team award winner. He has been very fortunate to have coached nine N.C.A.A. Honorable Mention All-American divers as well as seven N.C.A.A. All-American divers at Rowan University. Dave McNally is an elementary school teacher with the Gloucester Township Public School System with eighteen years of experience. Coach Dave currently resides in Wenonah with his wife, Melissa, and two children, Morgan and Nolan.
